

# **Competition Overview**

## **BEST Competitions**



- Hub Level (local competition)
  - Two divisions:
    - Robotics (the annual game)
      - Each team must submit a Project Engineering Notebook
    - The BEST Award (additional/optional competition)
      - Allows for school-wide student participation

#### Regional Championship

- Hub winners in both divisions advance to "Regionals"
- 10 or more hubs comprise a BEST region

#### National Championship

Regional winners in both divisions advance to the national championship

#### Robotics - The Game



- New educational theme/challenge and field each year
- Challenge and field kept secret until Kick Off Day
- Playing field is usually a 24' x 24' configuration
- 4 teams compete per 3-minute match
- Points awarded for successful completion of tasks
- Each team competes in 5-8 matches in a preliminary "seeding" round

### **Game Rounds**



- Seeding Round (5-8 matches per team)
  - Rank-order of robots by most points scored
  - Top 7 ranked teams advance to Semi-Final Round
- Wild Card Match (1 match)
  - Top 4 Project Engineering Notebook teams (not among the top 7 robotics teams) compete for the 8<sup>th</sup> slot in the Semi-Final Round
- Semi-Final Round (6 matches)
  - Top 7 + Wild Card winner to determine "Final Four"
- Championship Round (3 matches)
  - Top 4 teams

### The BEST Award



- The BEST Award is presented to the top three teams (1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup>) that best embody the concept of "boosting" Engineering, Science and Technology
- The BEST Award is the most coveted award in BEST
- Criteria:

Teamwork Ethics

Diversity of Participation Positive Attitude/Enthusiasm

Sportsmanship School/Community Involvement

Creativity

Application of the Engineering Design Process

- Kick Off Day (start of fall competition)
  - Unveiling of playing field and overview of game
- Mall Day (playing field set up at local mall)
  - Practice driving, community awareness
  - Help from hub in troubleshooting technical problems
- Game Day (Robotics and BEST Award competitions)
- Regionals (late fall)
  - Top teams in both divisions (Robotics and BEST Award) advance to a Regional Championship
- National Championship (following April)
  - Winners of regional championships
